- Emergency calls to the practice only during this time

## **OUR APPOINTMENTS HAVE CHANGED...**

- Longer 15-minute GP appointments for all patients
- More time with your GP
- Consultations not restricted to just one health issue
- Choose face-to-face or telephone, as appropriate
